Chef's Corner with Executive Head Chef Paul Roberts

ROAST CHICKEN THIGHS WITH ROSEMARY & GARLIC

I probably make this two or three times a month if not more. One of the simplest dishes to make and one of my favorites as well. I always enjoy eating whole cloves of garlic with bites of chicken. It keeps Rene away from me the following day. Enjoy with sautéed broccoli or green salad.

INGREDIENTS

- Bone in skin on chicken thighs, I like to get ones as small as possible
- One head garlic, lightly crushed each clove with skin on
- 2 tablespoons extravirgin olive oil
- 2 tablespoons roughed chopped Rosemary
- Kosher salt and fresh cracked pepper

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Preheat oven to 425°

Step 2: In a large sauté pan arranged chicken thighs in pan. Be careful not to crowd them, coat with olive oil, rub evenly salt and pepper and sprinkle on rosemary.

Step 3: Put in oven for 30 minutes, after 30 minutes add in the garlic.

Step 4: Return to the oven and cook for another 30 to 40 minutes. The chicken should be nice and crispy and the garlic should be creamy.

COURSE NEWS

This month the maintenance team started to apply wetting agents on the fairways as the days are getting longer and will start to get warmer as we head into the summer. The wetting agents are used to retain moisture in the soil to prevent it from getting hydrophobic in areas that get very dry, and will also help save water as well.

We also added iron to the mix to give the fairways a darker green, which also gives us a nice contrast between the fairways and rough.





New Augusta Sand!

We are continuing to move forward with adding new Augusta white bunker sand to our greenside sand traps. We are currently topping off Ranch #9 and then will start on the Canyon course in May.
