GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

As summer begins and the days get hotter and longer, the soil dries out much more quickly. Because of the high water cost, it is a constant struggle to make the best use of our resources. We've found that by using the soaker hoses placed to hit the dry spots on the course allows us to use the large sprinkler heads for a much shorter time.
