



GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE

We are very fortunate to have the current amount of ground water available to us so that we are not strictly buying from Otay. With the fertilizer application that we applied and proper irrigation we are able to maintain the course in very good condition. We also added a wetting agent application to help retain moisture and we put iron in the mix so the fairways look greener than the roughs giving the course a nice contrast between the fairways form the roughs.



Take a look at Vineyard 8 and Ranch 5 with the sightlines re-established.



Fall Maintenance is right around the corner. During these dates we will be 18 holes only as we let the winter rye grow in. Members, please be sure to schedule your tee times in advance!
