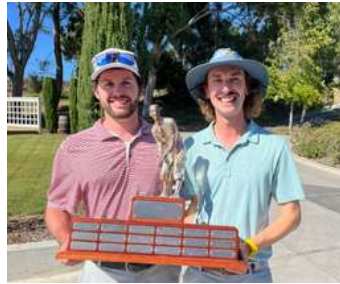

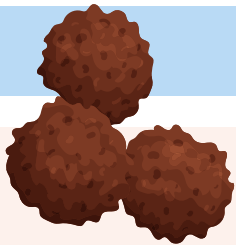

Chef's Corner with Executive Head Chef Paul Roberts

HOMEMADE MEATBALLS



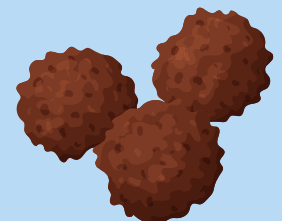
I love making these little meatballs, they are so simple and quick. Great for sandwiches or pasta with your favorite marinara sauce

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 pound ground pork
- ½ cup Italian breadcrumbs
- ⅓ cup milk
- ¼ cup onion diced
- ½ teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- 1 egg
- ¼ cup parsley chopped
- ¼ cup parmesan shredded
- salt and pepper to taste

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 400°F.
2. In a medium bowl, mix all ingredients until just combined.
3. Shape mixture into 48 meatballs, approximately 1 ½ tablespoons each.
4. Bake 18-20 minutes or until cooked through.



COURSE NEWS

We recently had some tree and bush work done with the removal of a large pepper tree and pompas grass in the middle of the tee complexes of Canyon 2/6/9. They were prohibiting turf growth with too much shade during the day as well as taking in plenty of water from the tees.



Where did all the water go??? As many have noticed our lakes on the course have dropped with their water levels. These lakes are connected directly to our irrigation system and are used in conjunction with well water (when available) to take care of the course. A reminder that all of our lakes are to be treated as Environmentally Sensitive Penalty Areas. The water in the lakes is used for irrigation throughout the year, it is to be assumed that the Penalty Area is full of water and unplayable year around. You may not enter or play a ball from these areas at any time. This not only protects the original intentions and design of the course, but keeps you from wandering into a stinky, potentially hazardous situation. Our lake levels will remain lower during this drought so as not to be wasteful, let's hope for rain soon!

Fall maintenance begins in September. Each course will be closed for approximately 10 days to do wall to wall aerification and overseeding of tee boxes and green surrounds. We will also be working on some small projects while the courses are closed.
